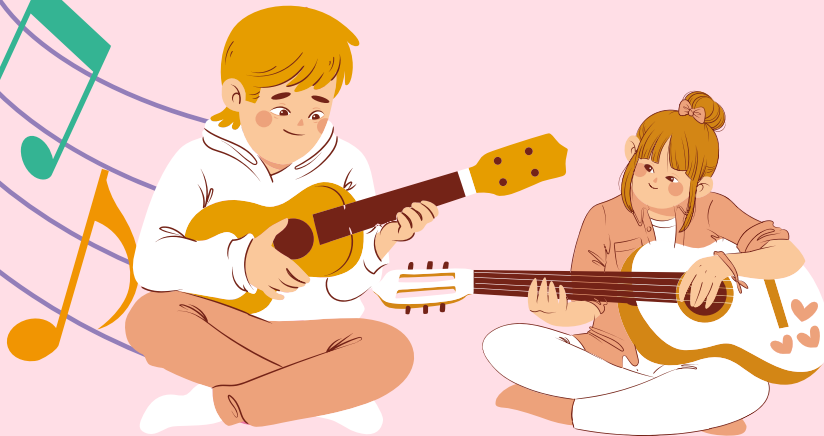

SEVEN STEPS TO BREAKING DOWN A TASK



1

UNDERSTAND THE TASK

What is the end goal? What are the requirements? This step involves reviewing all information about the task.

2

BREAK IT DOWN

Divide task into smaller, manageable parts. Each part should be a self-contained unit that contributes to the overall goal.

3

ESTIMATE TIME

For each small task, estimate how long it will take to complete. This will help in planning and scheduling.

4

PRIORITIZE

Prioritize the tasks based on their importance, deadlines, and dependence.

5

PLAN FOR BREAKS

Remember to schedule short breaks between tasks. This can help prevent burnout and maintain high productivity levels.

6

TRACK YOUR PROGRESS

Keep track of your progress as you work through the tasks. This will give you a sense of accomplishment.

7

REVIEW AND ADJUST

Regularly review your task list and progress. Adjust your plan based on priority changes or unexpected obstacles.

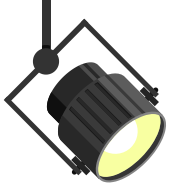

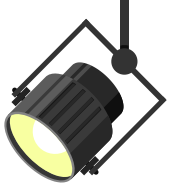

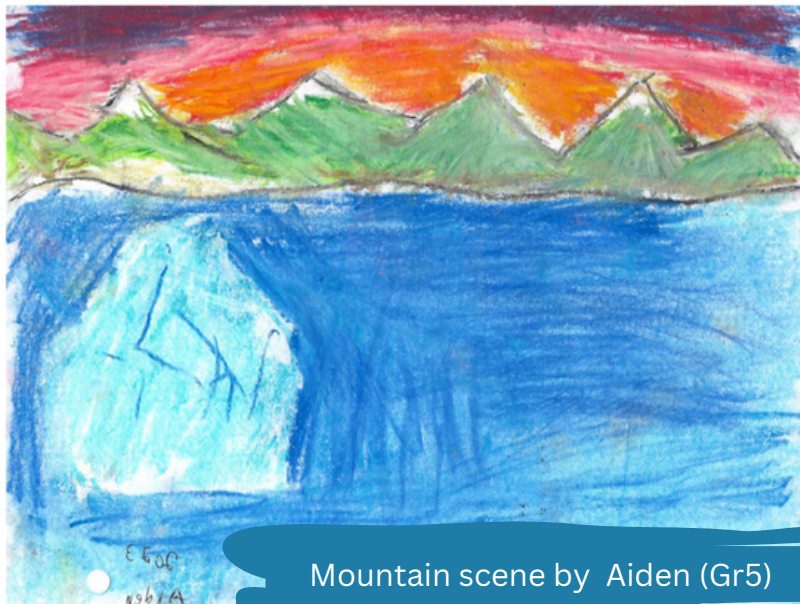


Estrella (Gr5) Time Capsule Self-Portrait

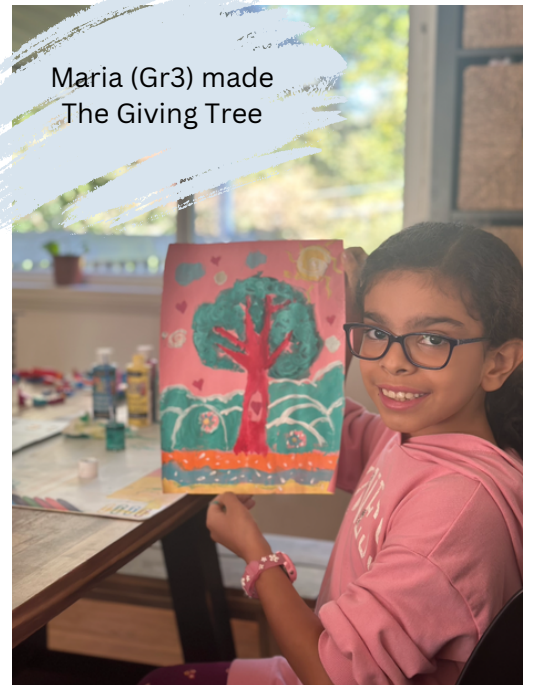


Cover of Explorer Logbook by Amy, Gr4 Social Studies

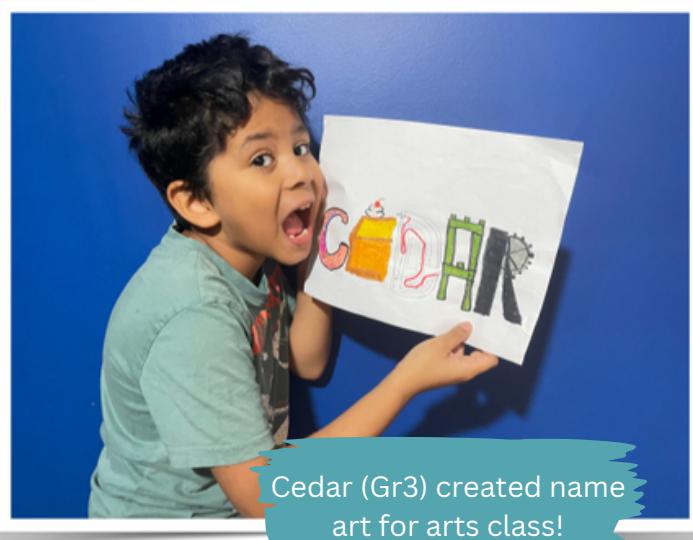




Dear Blankets,

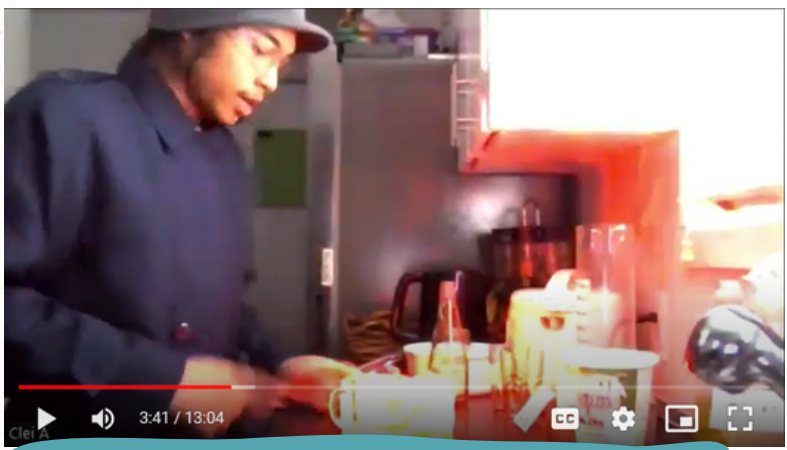
