CONGRATULATIONS TO TRAVIS HARFIELD!

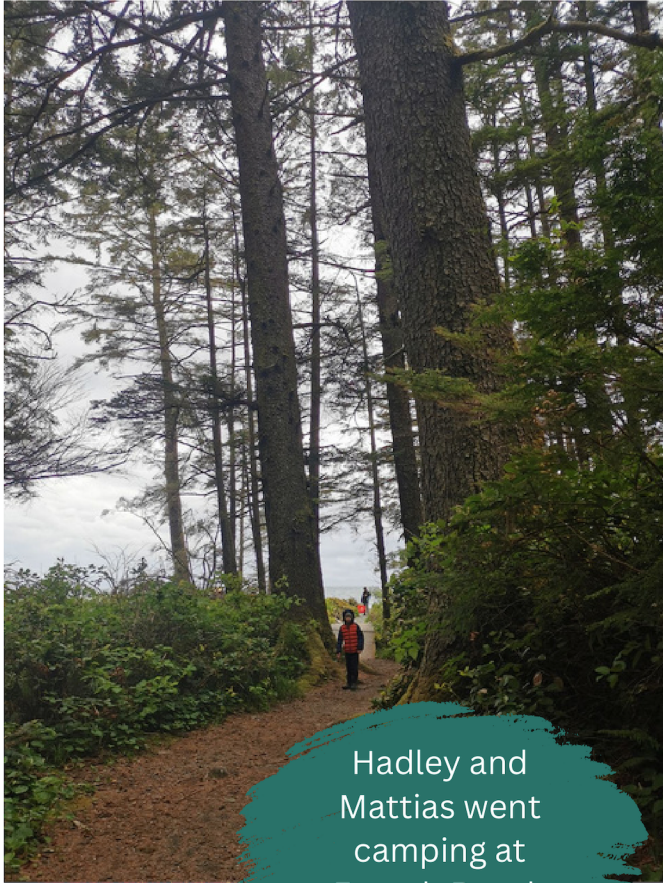
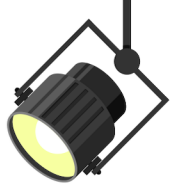

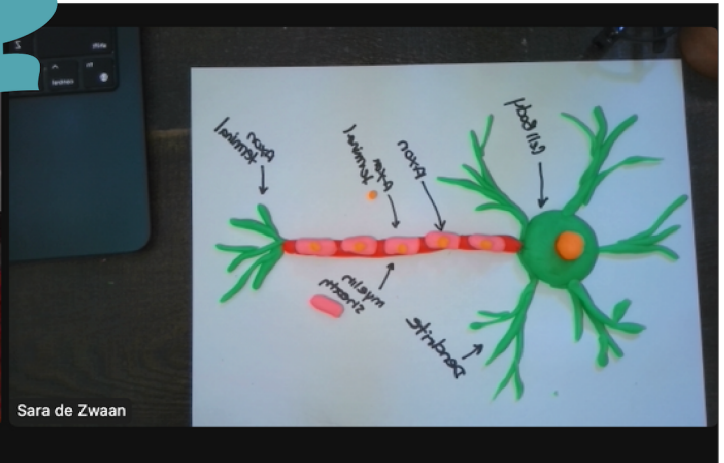

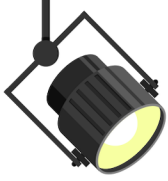

Her skirt is yellow like the sun.

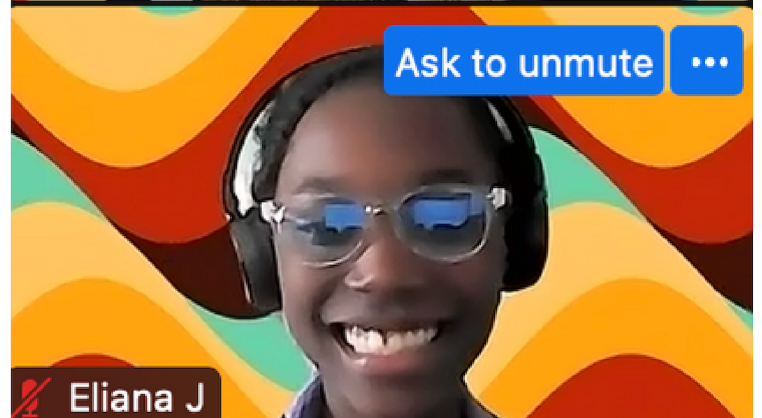
Julie can be very versatile,
