Thank you, WCAS families, for helping us celebrate faith, joy, and community in such a memorable way.



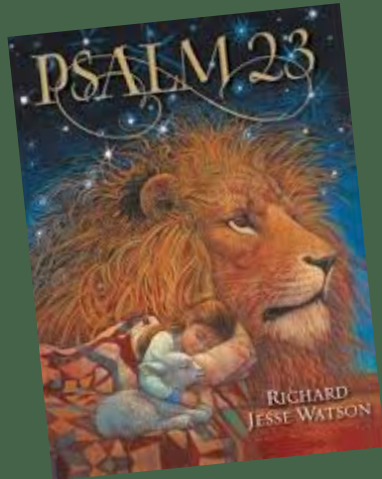

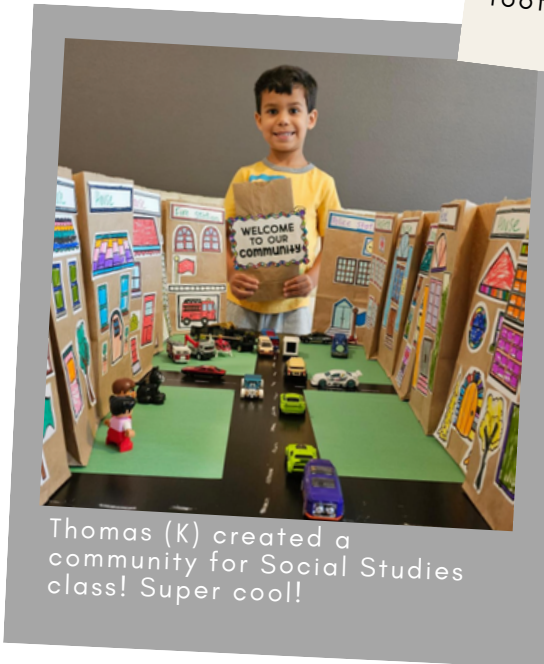

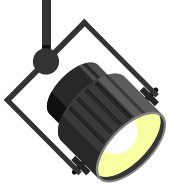

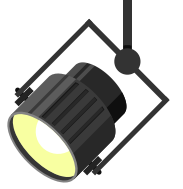

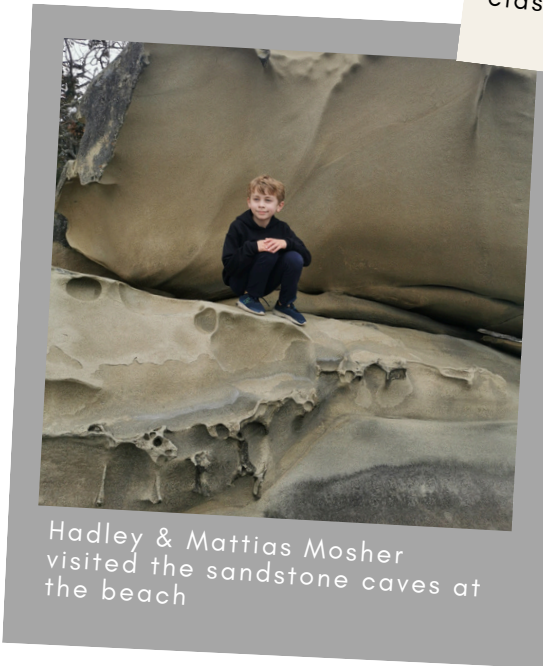

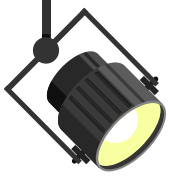

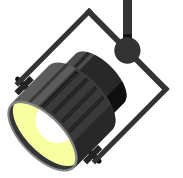

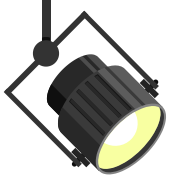

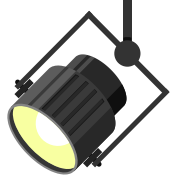
