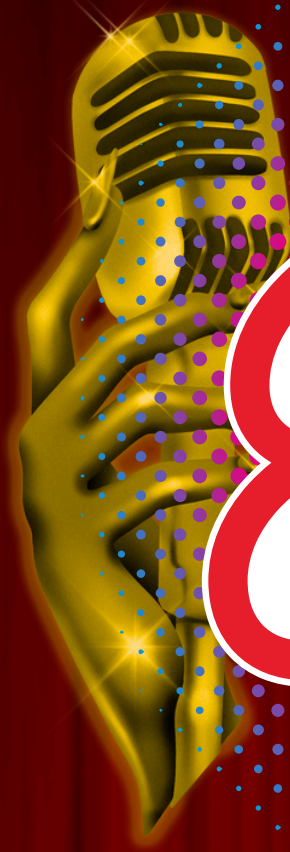

Performances can be live or pre-recorded and should be kept under 4 minutes.

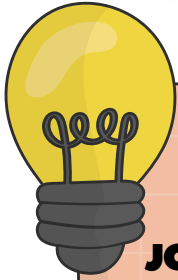
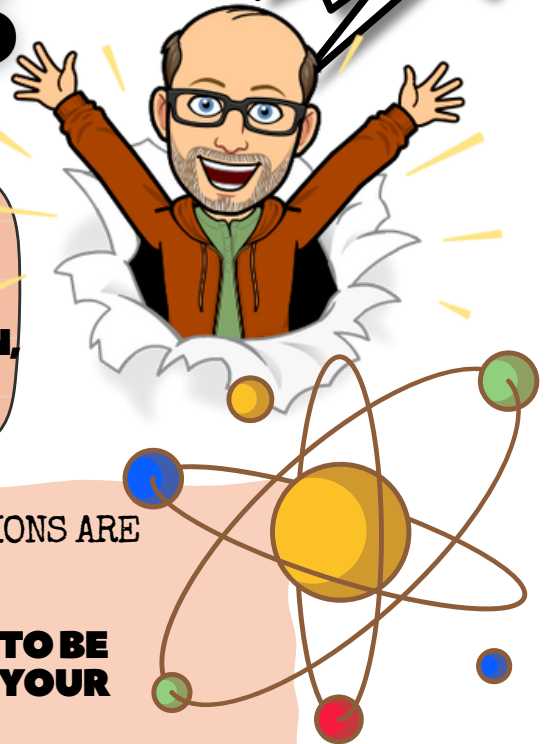

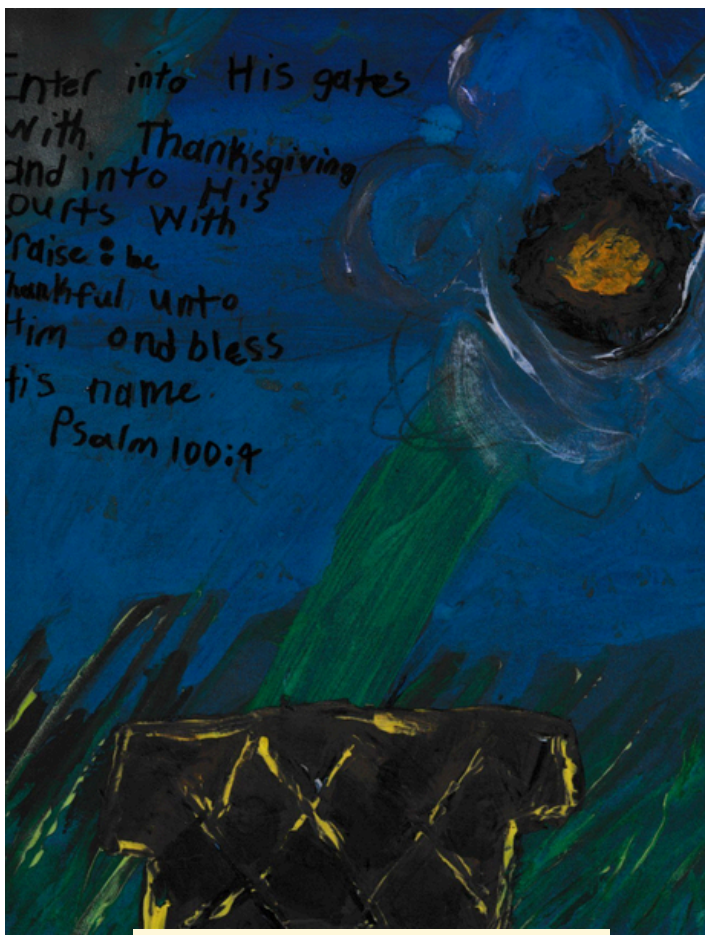

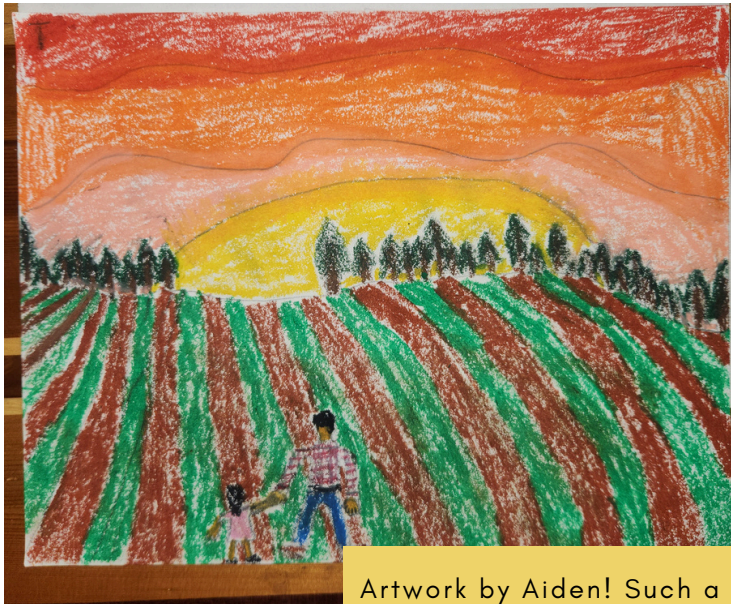

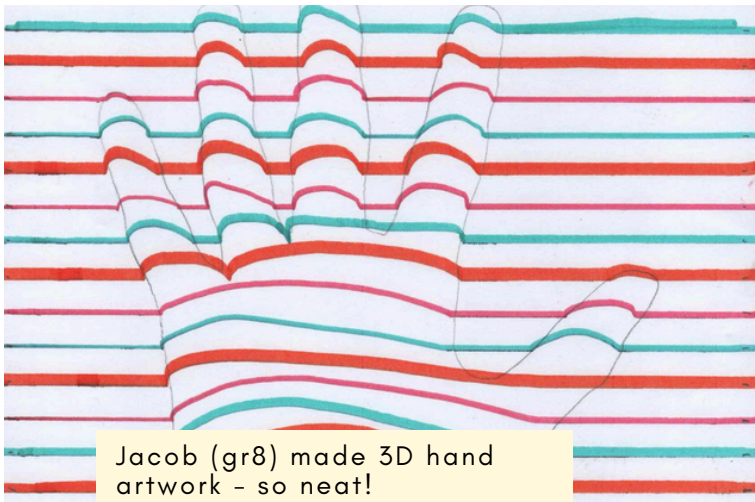
